

Academy of Fine Arts of the University of Zagreb announces the admissions into BA programmes for foreign applicants. In the academic year 2006/07 the Academy will take foreign students into the programmes listed below:

1. BA sculpture – 2 students
2. BA graphic arts – 2 students
3. BA animated film and new media – 2 students
4. MA art restoration and conservation (integrated 5-year programme):
 - sculpture – 1 student
 - painting – 1 student

Deadline for applications:

Applicants are asked to submit their applications from 30 August to 1 September 2006. The application should include:

Documents

1. CV
2. Birth certificate
3. High school/matriculation diploma and records of all four high school years attended (see below regarding the translation and recognition)
4. Proof of payment for the entrance procedure costs (paid to the account of the Academy).
5. A filled-in application form (at the Academy).
6. *Restoration and conservation applicants only:*
 - *certificate of general health status (including colour-blindness, claustrophobia, acrophobia)*
 - *two photographs*
 - *proof of no criminal record (at most three months old)*

Portfolio

The portfolio should contain works after nature and from imagination.

For the Department of Graphic Arts: 30 works in colour or drawings. They should demonstrate the candidate's interest for the medium and discipline.

For the Department of Sculpture: 20 drawings and 3 – 5 sculptures (gallery format). They should demonstrate the candidate's interest for the medium and discipline.

For the Department of Art Restoration-Conservation of Paintings: 10 drawings in pencil on paper (4 heads after a plaster model, 2 drapes, 2 still lives, 2 ornaments; size 70 x 50 cm) and 10 free motifs (minimum 5 in colour).

For the Department of Art Restoration-Conservation of Sculptures: 10 drawings in pencil on paper (4 heads after a plaster model, 2 drapes, 2 still lives, 2 ornaments; size 70 x 50 cm) and 10 free motifs.

For the Department of Animation and New Media: 30 works in colour or drawings. Candidates may additionally enclose their works on a video tape.

The entrance procedure with a practical exam of the applicants' artistic talent and skills will take place in the first week of September. Precise information regarding the entrance exam will be published on this web site in the last week of August.

High school diploma recognition

If you already have a high school/matriculation diploma you should have it officially translated, together with all high school records for four years of attendance. These documents should be sent to the Ministry of Science, Education and Sport of the Republic of Croatia for the recognition process.

You should send originals or officially certified copies of all the documents (both in the original language and official court interpreter's translations). In case you are still a high school student, you will start the procedure once you have received your diploma. The process of recognition is rather fast in the season of entrance exams. Also, you can attend our entrance exam without a certificate of recognition from the said Croatian Ministry. You will only need to produce the document in order to enrol.
